ORDER

" We are informed that some of the persons, who were involved in the murder of the lady have been arrested. While others have not been arrested so far. The learned Addl. Advocate General, Sindh and the learned Addl. Prosecutor General, Sindh on instructions of the Police Officers present in the Court, state that every effort is being made to arrest the remaining accused and hopefully they will be successful in the near future.

2. The sister of the deceased, present in the Court, has complained that she and other staff of the

Orangi Pilot Project (OPP) are being threatened. The DIG present in the Court has been instructed to provide requisite protection to them. We have also been assured that the learned counsel for the Complainant will also be provided the requisite protection.

3. The learned counsel for the Petitioners states that an application had been filed before the Inspector General of Police, Sindh praying that certain police officers, who were allegedly involved in the cover up, should be included and asked to join the investigation, as this would assist in reaching all the culprits in the matter. He states that the said application has not been decided. If any such application has been filed, we expect the IG to decide the same and to do the needful in accordance with the law, if possible, within three weeks.

4. Let this matter be re-listed for hearing after four weeks.
