Learned Addl. A.G. Sindh has submitted comments on behalf of Director General Private Schools, Education and Literacy Department, Government of Sindh in which various documents are annexed to show the different compliances and safety measures. In paragraph No.6 of the comments 59 schools have been highlighted to show the compliance of certain requirements through a checklist of 16 items. Respondents No.2 and 3 have also submitted their comments.

Secretary School Education & Literacy Department submits that in the ADP 2016-17 Program of 81 schools was taken for the construction of boundary walls and for the rest provision will be made in future budget to raise boundary wall being one of the basic components to ensure a foolproof security. Copies of all the comments have been supplied to the

counsel for petitioner, who needs sometime to go through the same and point out ~~any~~<sup>any</sup> lapses, if any.

Home Secretary also pointed out a letter written to him by AIGP Operation dated 24.05.2018 in which AIGP recommended certain security measures in para 3 of the letter. He further submits that on the next date he will also place on record some progress in this regard.
