

STATEMENT OF CHIEF SECRETARY SINDH

It is respectfully submitted,

That at the outset the undersigned submits that he has Great Respect and Honor for the Honorable Courts and he cannot even think not to comply the Orders of Honorable Courts.

It is further submitted that Government of Sindh feels its responsibilities & commitments regarding the safety of students who are going for their education.

In compliance of Honorable High Court Order in respect of the details of Educational Institutions & their security it is submitted as following,

A. Number of Educational Institutions:-

1. Government Educational Institutions (approximately)	46,056
2. Registered Privately Managed Educational institutions	12,958
3. Total Institutions	59,014

B. Category of Educational Institutions:-

1. Armed Forces Institutes.
2. Missionary/Cambridge/Agha Khan Board.
3. Private and Government Schools.

C. Types of Educational Institutions

1. Colleges
2. Higher Secondary
3. Secondary
4. Primary
5. Elementary

D. Security Status:-

1. **Armed Forces Institutes:** - Security is made by Armed forces and peripheral patrolling by Police.
2. **Missionary/Cambridge/Agha Khan Board:** - Internal security guards as well as Police deployment and peripheral patrol by Police.
3. **Private and Government Schools:** - Most of the Government Schools have one watch man and private institutions have private security guards.

2. It is further submitted that on 1st February 2016 in a cabinet meeting the security of educational institutions was considered in which it was briefed that in order to secure the Schools / Institutions by rehabilitating / repairing / raising / constructions of walls, Education & Literacy Department proposed a PC-1 and it was sent to the Planning and Development Department Government of Sindh, at the estimated cost of the Rs: 7636.079 million consisting of 8417 units in all Districts of Sindh. Technical committee of the P&D (Planning & Development) Department Government of Sindh considered the said PC-1 in its Meeting held on 17-2-2015 and it was decided that Education and Literacy department may prepare the projects for the areas which were declared highly sensitive by the Home Department and the Law Enforcement agencies in first phase. The verification by the concerned Deputy Commissioners is under process, verified list of Educational Institutions will be forwarded to Planning and Development Department for approval.

3. Necessary instructions to all Private Schools/ Institutions have been issued by the Director General, Sindh private schools registrations with regards to security measures to face any untoward situation. They were also directed to collect mobile Sims of emergency alert system/ code (*55#) from the concerned SSPs as per MoU signed between U-fone company and IG Police Sindh. A Performa containing 16 points covering most of safety measures to safe guard the students and staff has also been sent to the Principals/ Administrators of the Private Schools/ Institutions.

4. The teams of Directorate of private schools registrations are also visiting to ensure the implementation of such safety measures. The task of covering all institutions is under process and remainders have been issued. The private schools management association has also been involved in this behalf.

5. In order to provide foolproof security to the private institutions in Sindh as per decision taken by the home department, arms licenses will be issued to the School management/ Principals & Owners.


6. Necessary instruction have also been issued by the Director General, Private Schools/ Institutions Sindh to all the private managed institutions/ Schools to charge admission fee, tuition fee and annual fee only with the approval of the registration authority viz Directorate of private schools/ institutions. The said directions were published in the leading news paper of daily "Jung" dated 6-10-2015 that they will not charge any security fee. In case of failure, immediate action in accordance with the law shall be initiated leading to cancelation of their registration.

7. It is submitted that in this regard the detailed statement of Secretary Education & Literacy Department, Government of Sindh as well as Schools Security Emergency Response plan in case of Terrorism/Bomb/Fire and Earthquake in Sindh is annexed.

8. It is submitted that this is a big task and this can only be achieved by the cooperation and coordination between Government, Law enforcement agencies & Private School management considering their responsibilities in this regard.

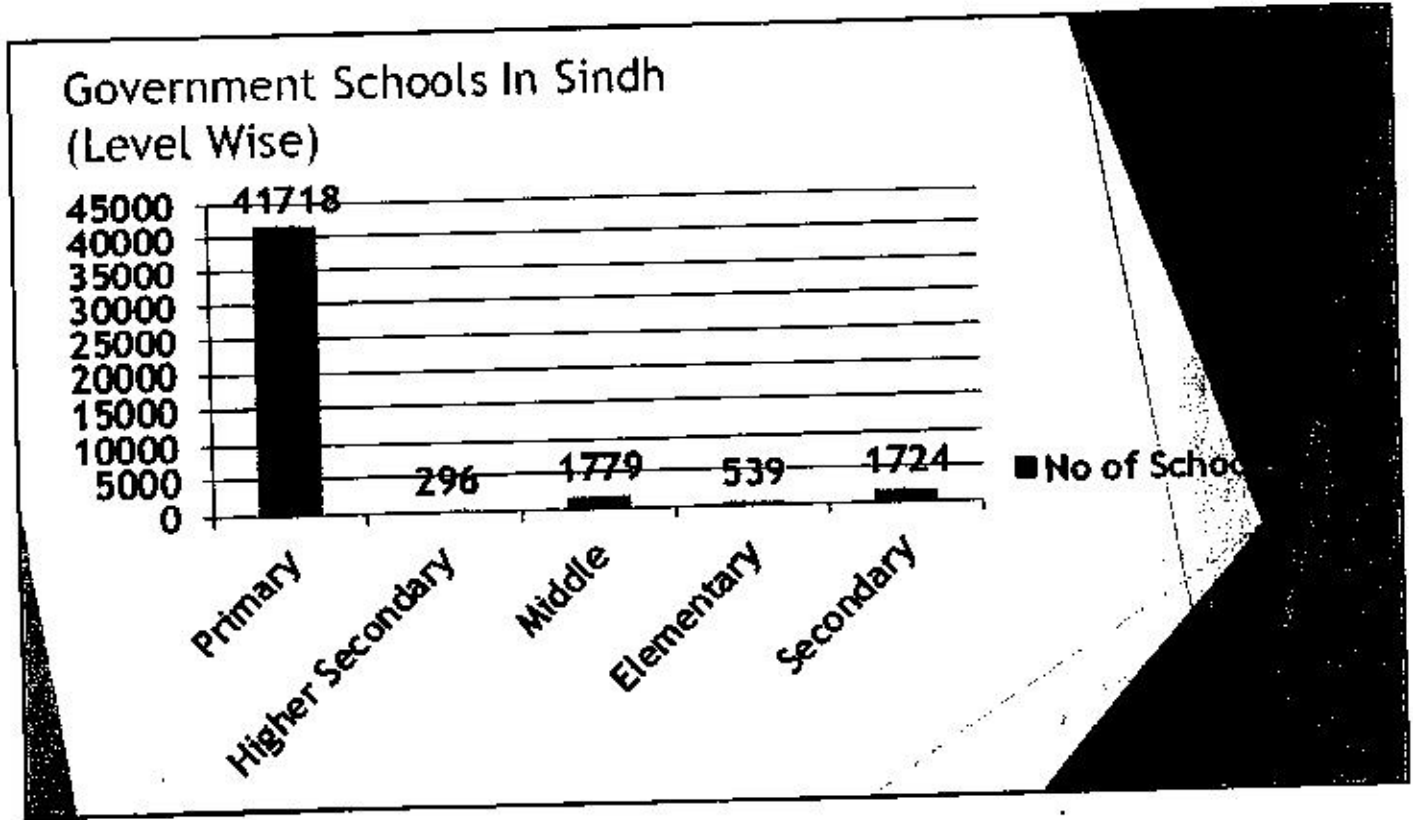

STATEMENT OF ALLEGED CONTEMNOR NO. 2

It is respectfully submitted in the interest of justice and equity that this Honourable Court may kindly dispose of the contempt application after considering the facts and grounds mentioned herein below :-

- 1) That the Honourable High Court of Sindh, vide Order dated 25.5.2015 and 27.7.2015 has been pleased to direct the Provincial Government to arrange necessary security measure to protect children of various schools from any untoward incident and to deploy security.
- 2) In order to secure the schools / institutions by rehabilitating / repairing / raising / construction of walls, Education & Literacy Department proposed a PC-I at an estimated cost of Rs.7636.079 million consisting of 8417 units all over Sindh which was sent to P&D Department for consideration. The Technical Committee of the P&D Department in its meeting referred the matter back to Education & Literacy Department for preparing estimates for the areas / district which were declared highly sensitive by Home Department and Law enforcement agencies in the first phase (Annex-I). Subsequently the department forwarded the list of indentified educational institutions to the respective Deputy Commissioners for verification vide letter dated 13-06-2015. So far 3030 educational institutions are verified by the Deputy Commissioners except 6 districts of which verification is still awaited. The estimates / rough costs of these 3030 institutions comes to Rs.1684.573 million regarding construction / reconstruction / raising / repairing of compound walls. Consolidated PC-I of all Highly Sensitive Institutions would be sent to the P&D Department for consideration after the verified list of remaining institutions of 6 districts are received. Besides a summary would be initiated for the Chief Minister, Sindh for provision of requisite funds for the said project being non ADP Scheme.
- 3) It is further stated that under the School Infrastructure Program, 92 schools of Karachi Region, 30 schools of Shaheed Benazirabad, 33 schools of Naushehro Feroze and 25 schools of Larkana District are being rehabilitated including the boundary wall component which is also being repaired, renovated / raised / rebuilt (Annex-II).

- 4) That it is further stated that necessary instructions were also issued by the Director General, Private Schools/Institutions Sindh, vide letter dated 6.10.2015 with regard to security measures to face any untoward situation in the Private Schools / Institutions (**Annex-III**). Private school owners were also directed for collection of mobile SIM of emergency alert system / code (*55#) from the Senior Superintendent of Police of the concerned area as per MoU signed between U-fone company and IG Police Sindh. A proforma containing sixteen points covering most of safety measures to safeguard the students and staff has also been sent to all Principals/Administrators of Private Schools/Institutions. The officers of the Directorate of Private Schools are also visiting various schools to ensure the implementation of such safety measures. The task of covering all institutions is under process and reminders are also being issued to concerned persons and also to Private School Management Associations. **Second progress report has also been submitted before the Honourable Court (Annex-IV)**. In order to provide foolproof security to the Private Institutions in Sindh as per decision taken by the Home Department, Arms Licences will be issued to the School Management/Principals/Owners. The Director General, Private Schools/Institutions Sindh has further intimated that all Private Managed Institutions/Schools have also been directed to charge only Admission Fee, Tuition Fee and Annual Fee with the approval of the Registration Authority viz Directorate of Private Schools/Institutions. The said directions have also been published in the leading newspaper of daily "Jang" dated 6.10.2015 (**Annex-V**) that they will not charge any security fee. In case of failure, immediate action in accordance with the law shall be initiated alongwith cancellation of registration of the said school.
- 5) It is further stated that in Sindh Cabinet meeting held on 1st February, 2016, it was also decided for establishment of sniper check posts at the roof top of respective private and public schools/colleges. It was also decided that the visibility of Police Force / Rangers during school working hours would also be ensured.
- 6) It is further stated that it was also decided by the Cabinet that GPRS coordinates of all private schools would be captured and integrated along with the already available GPRS coordinates of public schools so that the Rangers and Police can link it with their own system.
- 7) Education & Literacy Department has also established a centralized complaint cell on 8398 ILMI. Complaints regarding anything including security issues can be sent on this number through mobile. The same would be integrated with the system of law enforcement agencies.

8) Education & Literacy Department has also communicated the decisions of the Sindh Cabinet to Director General Rangers Sindh and Inspector General of Police Sindh regarding establishing of sniper check posts at the roof top of sensitive private / public schools / colleges alongwith visibility of police force / rangers during school working hours vide letter No.SO(Jud)CP-2259/2015 dated 03-02-2016 (Annex-VI).

2. That in the light of above submission, the compliance of the Orders of this Honourable High Court of Sindh is being made in letter and spirit by the Education & Literacy Department and highly sensitive schools/colleges identified by the Deputy Commissioners would be given priority in phase-I.

3. The Honourable Court may be pleased to dispose of the contempt application along with the original petition accordingly.

At the outset the Chairperson welcomed the participants of the meeting. The forum was apprised that Education & Literacy Department had submitted twenty three projects of identical nature at a cost of Rs.7636.079 million with the objective for repairing / raising and constructing compound walls in the existing primary and secondary schools and colleges of Sindh Province except District Sukkur in order to provide security measures for their protection from terrorism.

2. Chief (Edu) highlighted that PC-Is of the projects had not been prepared properly which lacked basic information like rough cost estimates, layout / site plan and summary sheet indicating number of primary / secondary schools and colleges for repairing / raising and construction of compound walls,

4. Regarding financing of non-ADP projects, Deputy Secretary (Dev), Finance Department advised that keeping in view the financial constraints being faced by Government of Sindh, the proposed projects should be implemented in phased manner. The Chairperson directed that Education & Literacy Department should prepare projects for the areas / districts which were declared high sensitive by Home Department and Law Enforcement Agencies in the first phase.

5. After detailed discussions, the forum took following decisions: -

Decisions

- i. The consideration of the projects (23 Nos) were deferred.
- ii. Sponsors would evolve criteria for identification of high sensitivity and security of schools and colleges and height and width of compound walls in consultation with Home Department and Law Enforcement Agencies.
- iii. Sponsors would get verified functionality and enrolment of the students in the proposed schools / colleges by Education & Literacy Department's staff of the respective district.
- iv. Sponsors would reflect / attach name, SEMIS number, enrolment of the students, coloured photographs, rough cost estimates and lay out plan / site plan for each school / college in the PC-I.
- v. Sponsors would prepare projects for the areas / districts which were declared high sensitive by Home Department and Law Enforcement Agencies in the first phase



Subject: **SECURITY ARRANGEMENTS IN PRIVATE SCHOOLS/ INSTITUTIONS IN
SINDH**

All the Privately Managed Schools/Institution are hereby directed to finalize their security arrangements/ plan before the end of the winter vacation as the Government of Sindh is not in a position to ensure police deployment. However the Government will ensure effective patrolling around the schools under threat and the Secretary, Home Department, Government of Sindh will issue arms licenses to the owner of the schools / Institutions within a week duly forwarded by Director General, Directorate of Inspection & Registration of Private Institutions, Sindh, Karachi.

There would be no compromise on the security of school children, the owner of the private schools should hire private security guards, prepare a specific security plan for their vans as terrorists may plant magnet bombs in school vans and other vehicles.

It was the responsibility of managements of the schools to make foolproof security arrangement, including fencing around school buildings, installation of CCTV cameras, allowing parking of vehicles at some distance from the school and ensuring children's drill within the premises of the school,

The management of the schools should minimize the entry-exit gates of the schools and also have different timing for their Junior and Senior sections.

Further directed to provide relevant data about school children, staff, their timings to the Police Station concerned as well as to the S.S.P and the Deputy Commissioner of the concerned District.

The Government is trying hard to eliminate terrorism and has appealed to the people to come forward as the Government alone cannot fight the menace of extremism. The School Management should keep an eye on any suspicious activity and should immediately report to the police. As you are aware that the price of petrol has decreased, please request the School Bus/ Van owner to reduce fair and compliance report be submitted to this Directorate by 26-01-2015.

SCHOOL SECURITY / EMERGENCY PLAN

In case of

TERRORISM / BOMB / FIRE / EARTHQUAKE EMERGENCIES

Introduction:

In the event of an act of terrorism, bomb threat, fire or earthquake, people generally panic and begin to run in different directions. Research shows that more injuries are caused from panic and stampede, than from the actual explosion / emergency. In a school, the situation can be quite dramatic unless the head and the teachers remain cool and in full control of themselves and the situation. This can be achieved by bringing all staff members, academic and administrative together to discuss the plan for such an emergency. If teachers are involved for planning the quickest escape routes etc. they will be more likely to remember what to do when an actual emergency occurs. It can be disastrous to ring the bell in an emergency situation and let the students go out of the school premises unprepared, on their own.

For preparing schools to deal with such incidents, some guidelines are presented in the following text. These are general guidelines and the actual Emergency Response Protocol needs to be developed by the individual schools themselves. All teachers, the support staff and workers must be involved in this exercise. After discussions a draft protocol should be written and the teachers should be asked to advise any other ways of improving it further to reduce the evacuation time. All students must be given full briefing on the final protocol, encouraging them to think positively, do their best and show their preparedness for such situations. Emergency drills must be arranged during different times of the day including recess time and at frequent intervals, initially fortnightly, then bi-monthly / quarterly to make the protocol more effective for various situations.

However, students in uniform with whom the Watchman / Security Guard / Teachers are familiar and only other teaching as well as administrative staff members duly displaying their ID Card round their neck be permitted entry within the school premises. Parents / Visitors must seek prior appointments and allowed visits during specific hours / days unless in emergencies, but must be properly identified and thoroughly frisked under all circumstances, before being allowed to enter the premises. Such a protocol be intimated through circulars to the parents in light of the prevailing high alert security measures, as per the directives of the Directorate of Education.

Following are the General Guidelines:



B- Bomb / Terrorist Act or Threat:

1. Receiving a bomb threat:

- i) **Convey Information immediately to the Manager Security, Principal and the area Police Station.**
- ii) **Evaluate the threat:**
 - a) Is it a hoax?
 - b) Might be real?
 - c) Don't know?
- iii) **Immediately proceed further in all Cases:**
 - a) **Conduct a comprehensive search preferably without evacuation i.e. having all the staff speedily search their different work areas, in addition conduct a low profile search i.e. of exterior grounds and public areas of the facility so that the entire facility is covered.**
 - b) **On serious apprehension prepare to evacuate partially or fully and then search.**
- iv) **Meanwhile, fill in the enclosed Bomb Threat Checklist - Part I and II.**
- v) **In the end after the all clear signal, continue normal course of the day.**
- vi) **Submit a report of the incident to the Principal and keep the record for future reference.**

2. Finding a suspicious parcel / briefcase / package

If in case a suspicious object is found then immediately co-ordinate with the government agencies and the emergency services.

- i) **Under no circumstances should it be touched, tampered or moved.**
- ii) **Immediately report the object to the Manager Security or the Principal; and follow their instructions.**
- iii) **If the suspicious object is external to the building area then immediately evacuate the occupants to the safe area somewhere in the building. Or in case the object is internal to the building then immediately evacuate the occupants to the safe area, which is atleast a 1000 feet away from the building; ideally upwind and uphill.**
- iv) **Cordon off the suspected area and no vehicles or pedestrians should be allowed inside this perimeter.**
- v) **Start searching for the secondary device.**

C- Action Plan

1. Evacuation:

- i) Get the emergency alarm systems activated.
- ii) Call 15 (24 hours Police Help). Give them the school address.
- iii) Keep a school map ready for the emergency personnel.

2. On hearing the Emergency Alarm Bell, Students must:

- i) Stop whatever they are doing.
- ii) Leave their bags, books, lunch boxes, etc. as searching for belongings and then carrying of bulky bags can hinder speedy evacuation.
- iii) Every student must quietly and briskly leave the classroom, in a queue.
- iv) No running on stairs is allowed.
- v) Assemble in the pre-designated emergency assembly area.
- vi) Stay with their respective classmates.
- vii) Not run to other classes to join their siblings, friends or parents who are staff members.

3. The Teacher in the Class is responsible for:

- i) The class evacuation and assembly (whether she/he is the class teacher or-not).
- ii) Turn off all lights, fans, electrical appliances and equipment.
- iii) The teacher must be the last to leave the classroom.
- iv) Take with her/him the class attendance sheet.
- v) In the assembly area, the teacher must count the students and make sure that no one is missing.
- vi) If possible, the students should be taken to pre-arranged safer places in the neighbourhood. Several places can be used.

1. Issuance of Identity cards to all the concerned working/ studying in the School premises (Students/ Staff and Drivers of the schools respectively).
2. Un-known persons visiting the premises should not be allowed without proper identification.
3. Private Vehicles should not be allowed in the premises of the school.
4. The vehicles of the employees working in the school should also be parked adjacent to the boundary wall / preferably out side of the School / Institution.
5. Any other appropriate measures for security of the premises may be taken as deemed fit in the present situation may also be taken.

The security measures adopted in the prevailing situation may be communicated at an earliest possible for onward transmission to the quarter concerned for information.





In Continuation of this Directorate letter No. DIR/PIS/EDU/GOS/44/ (10790-10795)/2009 Dated 21-10-2009, I am pleased to enclose herewith an Advisory Paper, comprising a format of guidelines on "School Emergency Response Plan" in case of any act of Terrorism / Bomb / Fire / Earthquake. These guidelines must be thoroughly reviewed and discussed with the entire Academic, as well as Administrative staff for its effective implementation. This is essential so as to ensure the maximum safety of the school children and staff members in case of any such unfortunate eventuality.

The schools are also individually required to prepare their own Emergency Response Protocol with respect to their school location and ground realities in light of the enclosed General Guidelines and share the same with the parents to seek their assistance in advising the children of its importance without creating a scare / panic in them.

Drills of the Security Plan must be held at regular intervals and duly recorded in the daily diary of school activities.

A copy of such a protocol must be kept available at the reception office at all times. Officers of the Directorate will review the same on their visit to the school and non-compliance of any of its provisions will be seriously reviewed as a breach of the schools' registration conditionalities.
