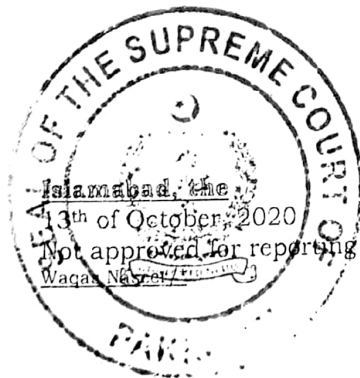

2. In our order dated 01.09.2020, NEPRA was directed to submit its report in terms of the proceedings under Section 26 of the Act. NEPRA has filed its report and sought further time for submission of latest report. Four weeks time is allowed to them for submission of the report.

3. Learned Attorney General for Pakistan has stated that the Federal Government would like to give a presentation on measures it is taking to ensure continuous availability of electricity to the people living in Karachi. Let such presentation be made within two weeks time and the matter be listed for hearing after four weeks.
